Using the Whiteboard Function can be used to prepare lessons ahead of time when not connected to a computer. These instructions can help you do this.

On your iPad, click the Doceri App.

On your iPad using the Doceri App, select “from my iPad alone”. This function is available if you are using “Airplay”.

You would be using this if you have an AppleTV or the Reflector App.



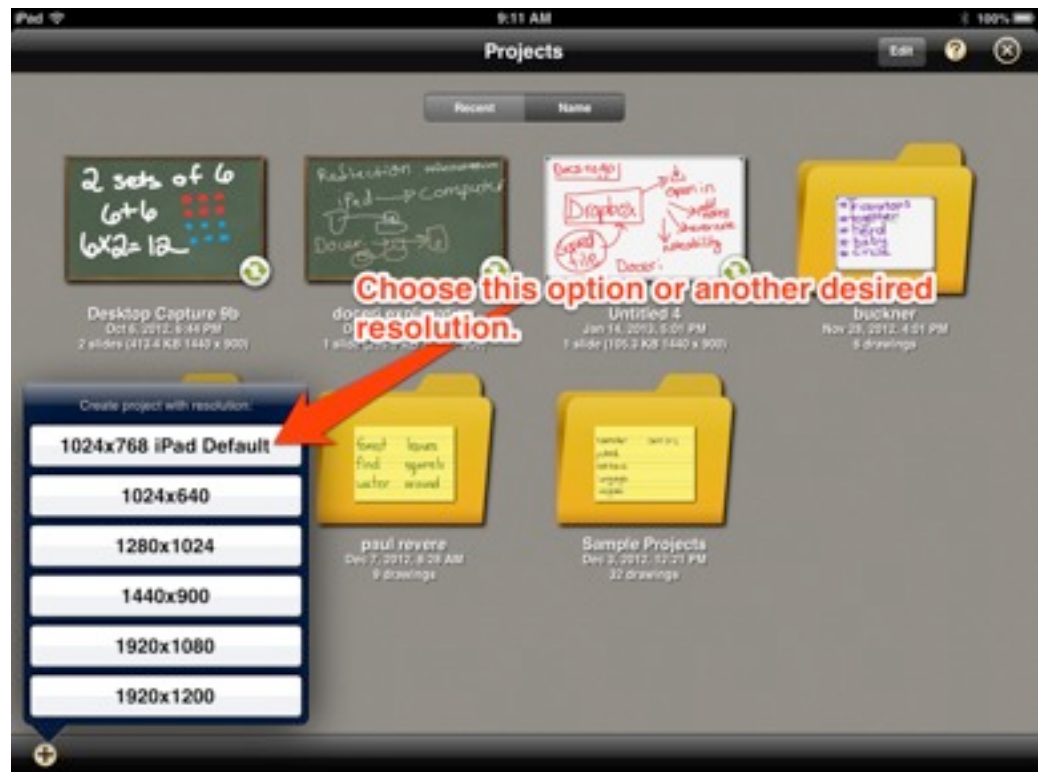


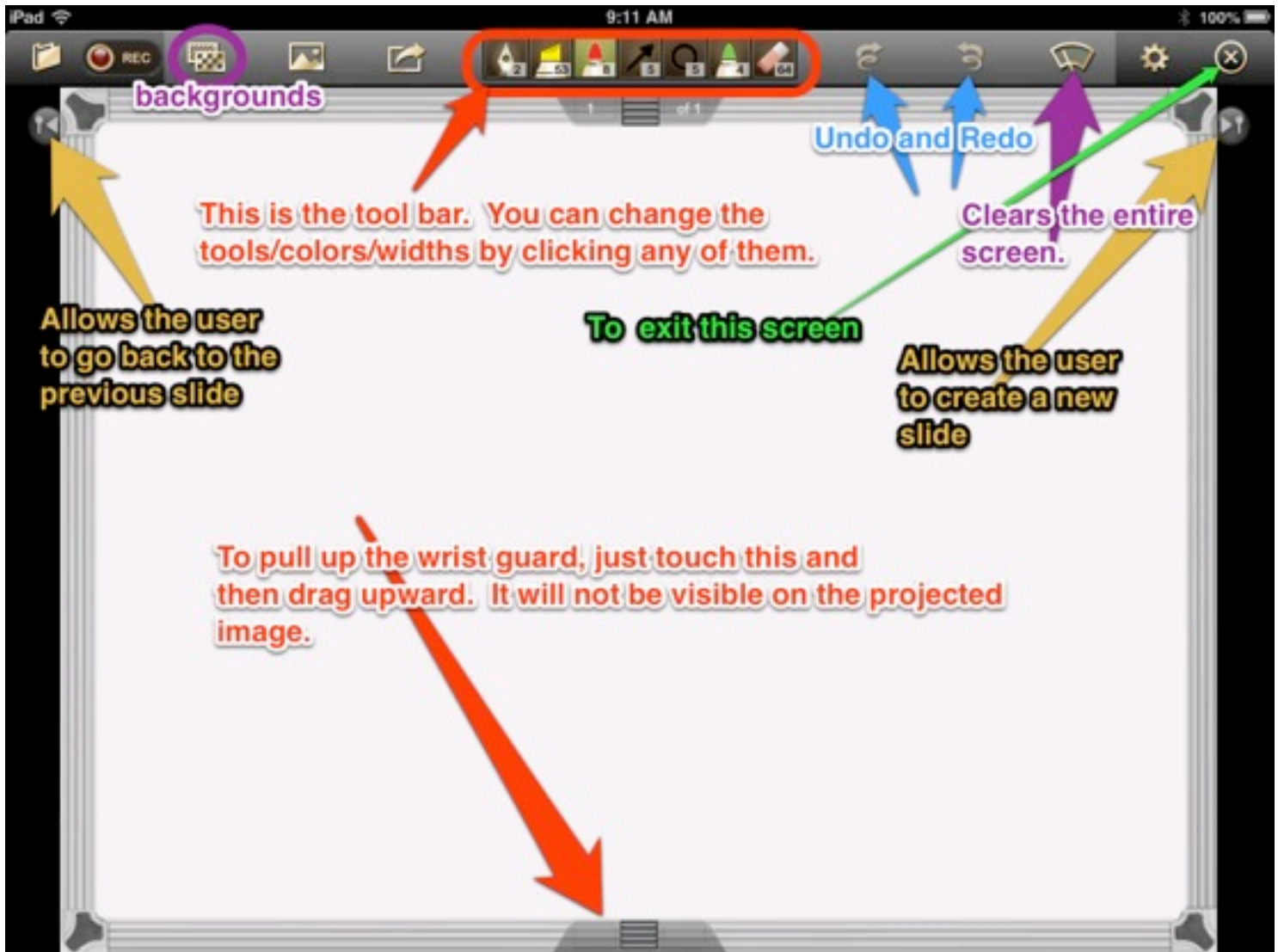
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Click the plus sign at the bottom left of the screen.

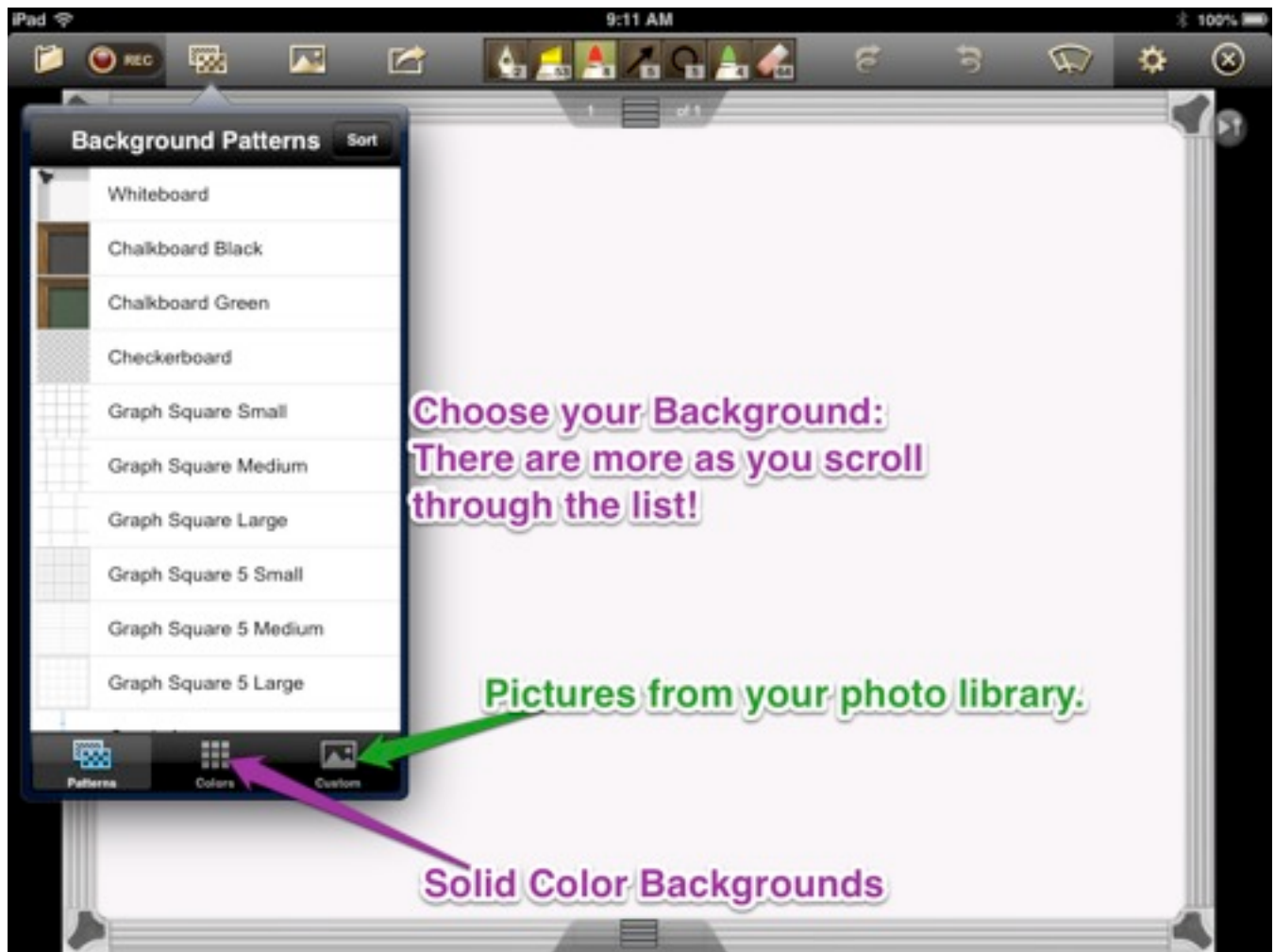
The resolution is the size the whiteboard will project. The best choice is the iPad default. If you are having trouble, check your projector settings.





This screen shot outlines some of the functions found in the drawing mode. The wrist guard noted above can help the user to not accidentally make marks with the wrist. It's a good idea to use with students or anyone not used to using a stylus on an iPad screen.

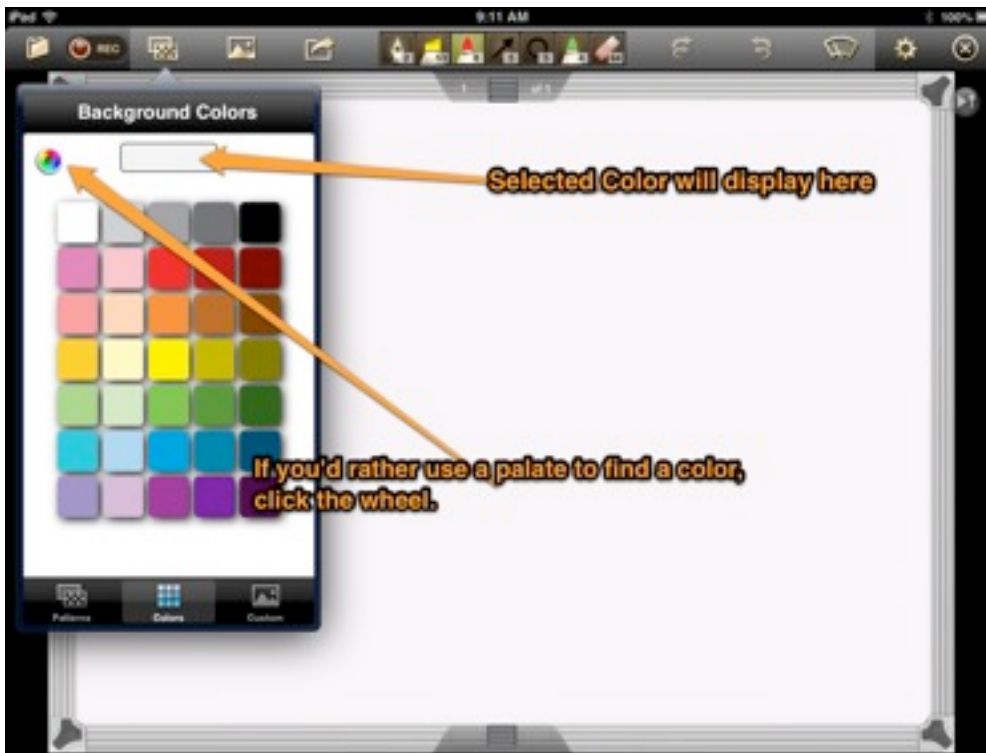
Undo and Redo will take away or rewrite writing stroke by stroke. The windshield wiper will clear the entire slide. The gray pin at the upper right hand corner will create a new slide without erasing the current slide. The opposite gray pin in the upper left corner will take you back to the previous slide.



Here are the backgrounds to choose from in the whiteboard. Be sure to scroll through the pattern list to see all the amazing options you can use for a background!

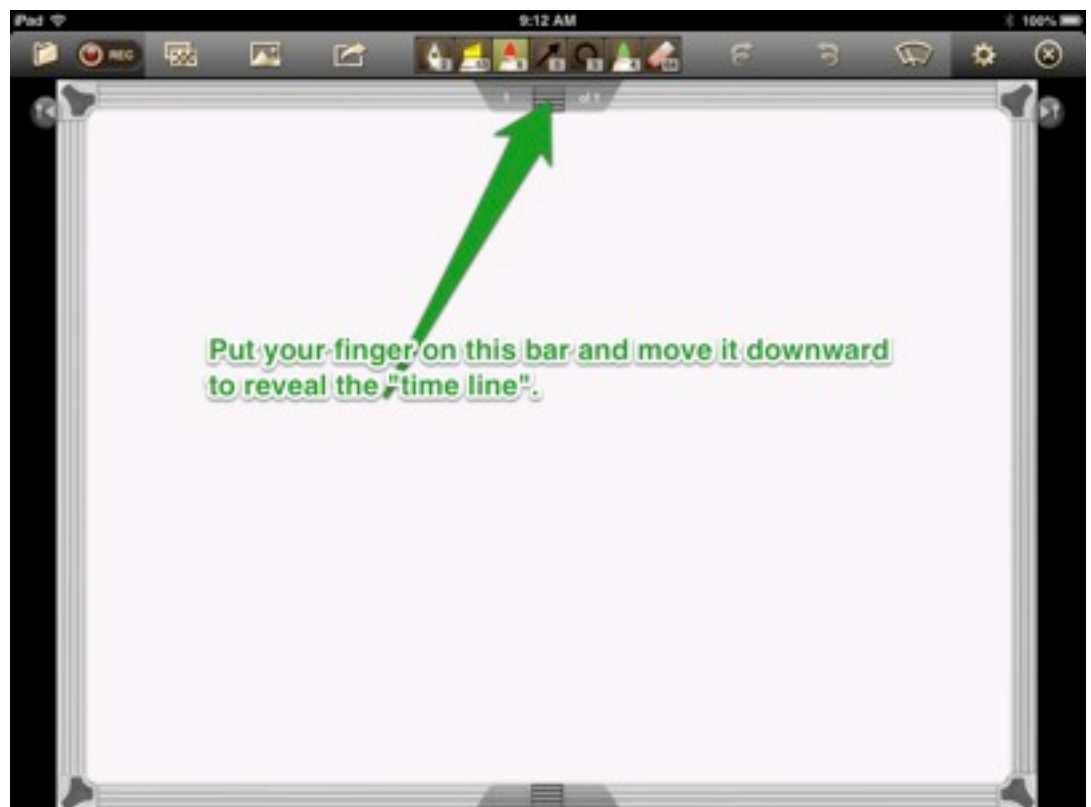


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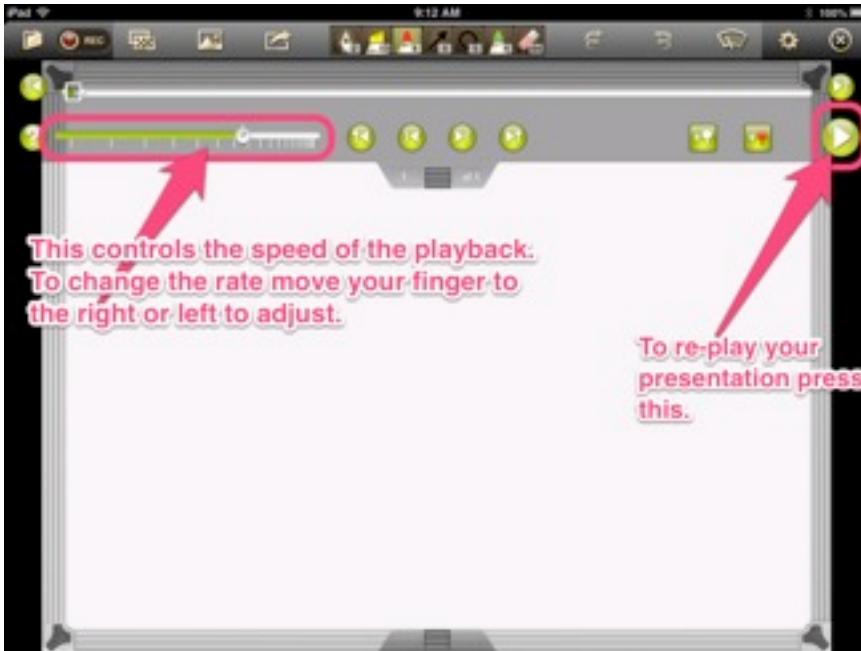
This is the Background color option, you can change how you view the colors by clicking the wheel. This will change from a whiteboard to whatever color you choose to have as a background.

This is the "time line" bar. You can access it easily by putting your finger on the tab and move it downward.





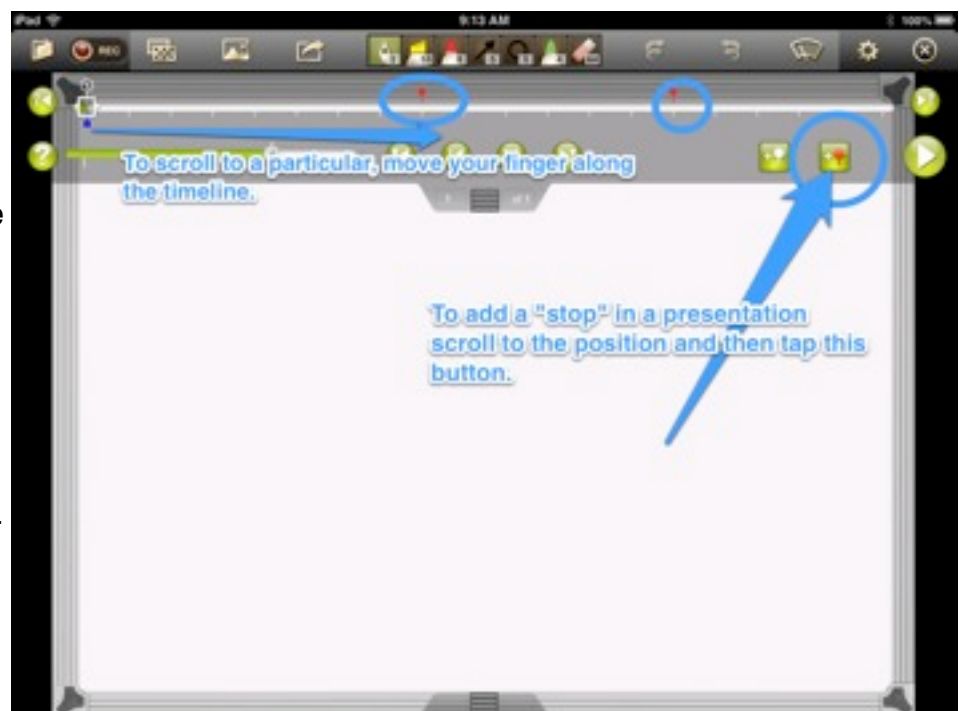
The time line is a great feature found on the Doceri Whiteboard. In preparing presentations, the user can replay all strokes by pressing the play button below. You can use the speed controls to alter how quickly the writing appears. This is a great feature to use with students!



These are the controls found on the time line.

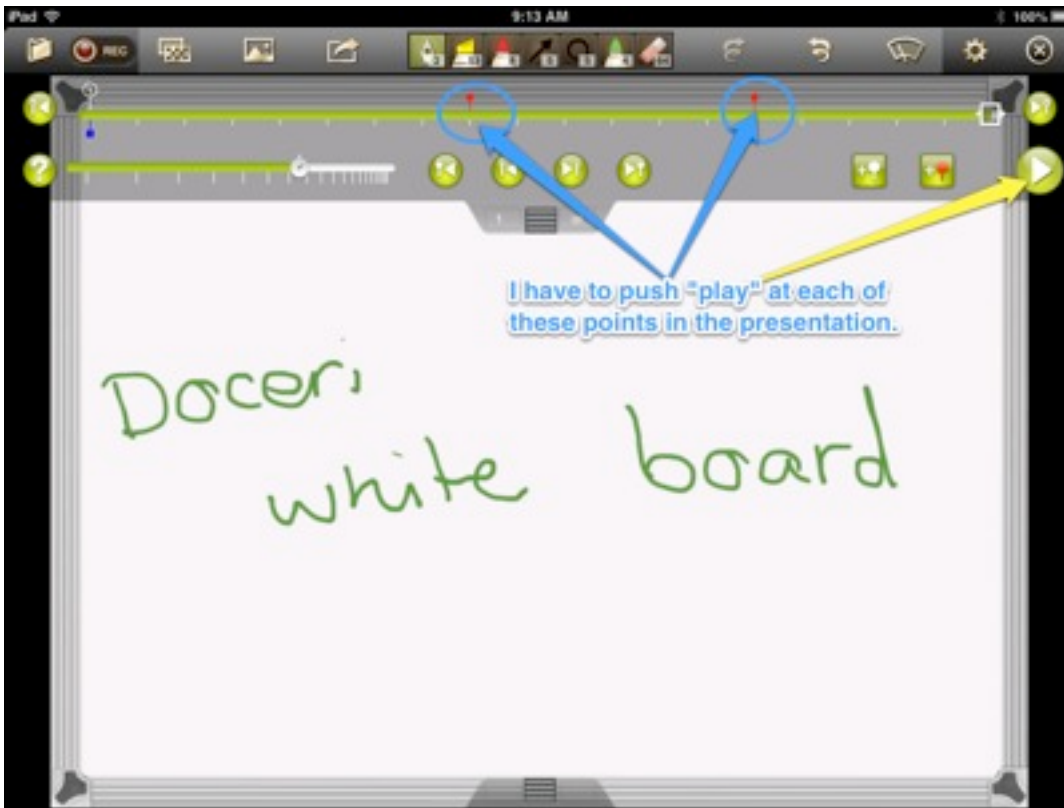
Moving your finger along the time line will allow you to move forward or rewind your presentation.

The red “stop” pins will stop the presentation at that point until “play” is pressed again. See the next screen shot for more details.

The stops can be a great tool in controlling the presentation.
