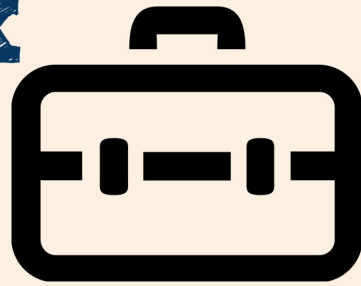

### Canvas

Include discussions, assignments, quizzes, and collaboration into your lesson plan.

Project discussions, assignments, quiz questions during class for verbal feedback.



### CSDDocs

Allow pairs or groups of students to work on the same document simultaneously.



### Nearpod

Let your slideshows become interactive with periodic quizzes, discussions, etc. to actively engage students.

Receive instant data during instruction to provide individual and whole class feedback.



### Randomly

Use this iPhone app to call on random students or create random groups in seconds.



### Zaption

Create and deliver interactive video lessons with text, image, drawings, and multiple choice, check boxes, and free responses.

Use the presenter mode to gather real-time data as you go through the lesson. Share out responses for feedback and discussion.



### Canvas

Create groups for assignments, discussions, and collaborations, and even allow self sign-up.



### Today's Meet

Create a private online chat where students can send in questions, comments, or answers to questions during instruction.

Share out answers or comments from the discussion feed or respond to students in the chat.



### Team Shake

Use this app to create groups randomly, by gender, or skill level.



### Quizizz and Kahoot

Gather quick formative data, in an interactive multiple choice competitive game, using any devices with internet.

Reshow questions and answer graphs for discussion and verbal feedback.
