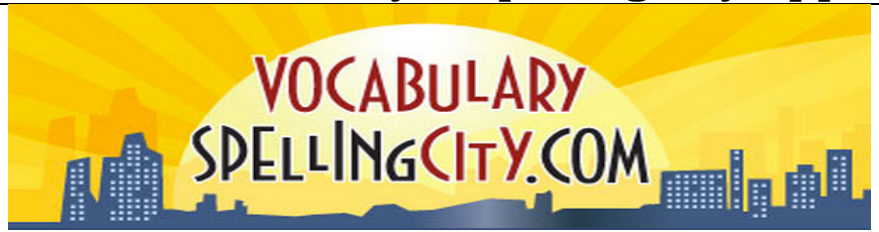


Teaching Vocabulary with the Vocabulary & Spelling City App

Go to <https://www.spellingcity.com/Create-an-account.html>
 And create a teacher account.
 **Make your username something you are okay giving to students as a way to search you if needed.



Once your account is created, add your desired vocabulary terms to a new list. Be sure to name it, add a description if needed and select the grade level. Save.

The next screen will ask you to verify the words and definitions by giving you a list of pre-selected definitions to pick from OR you can create your own at this time.

If you are doing this as a class (with your students) this could be a good time for the class to decide which definition is a best-fit, or if you need to create your own class answer.

*Note: you can only pick ONE definition.

Once you've selected what you prefer, hit "I'm Done" at the bottom of the screen to save & move on.

<p>2. After lists are created you/ your students can access them to practice with and play games either online or using the SpellingCity App.

The “Teach Me” option spells the word, pronounces it and uses it in a sentence aloud for students.

The games options (in the free version) are mostly matching, mixed up sentences, word search, etc. but CAN be accessed from home for students to practice for FREE ☺
